2022 Overview

- High Tide Global was officially established and Non-Profit status was confirmed

- Superhero Program was launched in Mexico and is 100% supported by High Tide Global Funds

- Began working with LAUSD (Los Angeles Unified School District) to develop plans to champion other programs in the area and HTG gifted to LAUSD the Superhero program

The Steps to Becoming a Superhero

In 2022, we partnered with the Superhero program to bring this world-class curriculum to several schools and afterschool programs in Mexico, Colombia, and Uganda. Working with more than 450 students we are laying the foundation for more champion schools worldwide. High Tide Global started talking with





LAUSD (Los Angeles Unified School District) to bring the Superhero programming to their district in 2023, identifying the Black Student Achievement Program as the first group to participate in the Superhero program in the Spring of 2023.



Tree of Life Medical Centre - Uganda

In December 2022, a momentous occasion marked the official ribbon-cutting ceremony of the Tree of Life Medical Centre, nestled within the Garden of Knowledge school in Uganda. This significant event was attended by our Founder & CEO Hazel Ortega and Founders Carolina Lopez, Alicia Holmes, and Annmarie Bhola. Since that memorable day, Garden of Knowledge, with the unwavering support of High Tide Global, has



embarked on a transformative journey. High Tide Global's support has not only facilitated essential projects like ensuring access to running water and implementing sanitary solutions at the school. Still, it has also allowed the acquisition of additional land. This newly acquired parcel of land became the canvas for planting maize (corn), a venture that has yielded a bountiful harvest now safely stored. Furthermore, through High Tide Global's efforts, we began planning to equip this newly built hospital with telehealth access, running water, hospital equipment (beds, etc.), and electricity for the hospital. These initiatives are becoming a reality in 2023 (and will be included in the 2023 report).
